_____ ANDY AND NEVABELLE HOWE SCHOLARSHIP (\$150 - \$75 each semester) (selected by personal interview with scholarship committee)

Applicant must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be a Buffalo County male 4-H member or former male member.
- 2. Prefer recipient have at least two years of 4-H crop work.
- 3. Based on financial need and 4-H achievements.
- 4. For a freshman at any Nebraska state college, university or technical school.
- 5. Recipient must notify the Buffalo County Extension Office of acceptance by August 15.
- 6. Money will be sent directly to bursar of selected school.
- 7. Recipient must use the scholarship within six months after the date of acceptance.

BANKERS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS (5) (\$500 fall semester)

Applicant must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be a senior in high school.
- 2. Be a Buffalo County 4-H or FFA member.
- 3. Scholarship must be used to attend vocational, technical or academic school.
- 4. Based on academic achievement and financial need.

BUFFALO BELLES HORSEMAN SCHOLARSHIP (\$200)

Applicant must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Currently enrolled in Buffalo County 4-H Horse program and two years previously.
- 2. Brief essay centered on 4-H experiences and their value to future.
- 3. Scholarship must be used to attend vocational, technical or academic school.

BUFFALO COUNTY 4-H SCHOLARSHIPS (6) (\$500 - \$250 each semester)

Applicant must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Currently enrolled in Buffalo County 4-H program.
- 2. Statement of 4-H activities, awards or honors (be specific)
- 3. Number of years in 4-H, a criteria for selection.

RONALD AND JAQUELYN KEGLEY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP (\$650 fall semester)

Applicant must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be a current, graduating senior residing in Buffalo County, Nebraska.
- 2. Be in top 50 percent of his/her class **include** a letter from school stating class rank.
- 3. Be enrolled full time (minimum 12 hours) in undergraduate study at an accredited, tax-exempt school or institution of higher learning.
- 4. Selection is based on involvement in 4-H and involvement in non-academic, extracurricular activities.
