

# ROY AND DORIS ABOOD SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

## Deadline:

- April 1<sup>st</sup> of each year

## Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a current, graduating senior of a Nebraska High school
- Must be enrolled full-time (minimum 12 hours) in undergraduate study at the **University of Nebraska – Kearney**, in the upcoming fall semester.
- Scholarships will be awarded to UNK-bound graduates of Nebraska-area high schools
- Award to first generation college students (A first-generation college student is defined as a student whose parent(s)/legal guardian(s) have not completed a bachelor's degree. This means that you are the first in your family to attend a four-year college/university to attain a bachelor's degree).

## Selection Criteria:

- Financial need
- Scholastic achievement
- Involvement in non-academic, extra-curricular activities including community, charitable and youth group oriented activities.
- 250-word essay submission explaining “Why college is important for my future and how this scholarship will help.”
- Submission of the application by the deadline date

## Scholarship Award:

- This \$1050 scholarship is awarded at the beginning of the first semester of the first year of higher education
